Objective	<p>As part of Community Services #1's (CS#1) Wellbeing Hub, the Learning for Wellbeing project provides social emotional learning support to school students who may find engaging in school difficult. Support is provided through Learning for Wellbeing Clubs conducted at host schools.</p> <p>The Clubs assists in developing young people's confidence and helping them socially and emotionally to participate in school in a more meaningful way. The Learning for Wellbeing mentor provides after school support to individuals, or small groups of students, focusing on social and emotional learning activities that are facilitated by CS#1 staff.</p>
Duties	<p>Contribute to a safe and welcoming learning environment for children.</p> <p>Support students individually, or in small groups, to participate in session activities.</p> <p>Assist students to engage with peers, other mentors and the facilitator in a positive way.</p> <p>Build appropriate, child safe relationships with students, other mentors and facilitator.</p> <p>Observe and provide anecdotal evidence of student progress.</p> <p>Participate in relevant training.</p> <p>Abide by CS#1 code of conduct and host school's requirements.</p>
