	Work with the Team Leader to implement the successful planning, implementation and evaluation of a curriculum-based program that is reflective of the Early Years Learning Framework.
	Contribute to the ongoing development of the Quality Improvement Plan for the service.
	Assist with the documentation and assessment of children's developmental progress against the learning outcomes, establishing further learning goals.
	Ensure child safety through active supervision and report all issues in line with Mandatory Reporting requirements.
	Follow all risk management policies and principles in work practices and

ensure incidents and events are appropriately reported and escalated.

Maintain accurate records, whilst adhering to ethical privacy and confidentiality principles.

Perform other duties as directed, commensurate with the skills and expectations of the role.
